GENERAL INFORMATION

For campers ages 2.5 - 5

**Updated May 2020*

Thank you for choosing Camp Sunny Jr!

Please read all of the important information below before the first day of camp and complete any other necessary forms.

Check in / Check out

- All campers need to be signed in and out from Camp Sunny Jr. For the safety of our campers, please bring photo ID for check out every day. Please allow extra time for drop-off and pick-up as we work to get everyone through our screening process.
- There will be a message board at the sign in desk, with our daily schedule and current location labeled on a map of the facility, as well as important reminders and information.
- Activities start at 9:00 AM. Early drop-off for morning and full-day camps begins at 7:30 AM. If your camper is not full-day, pick-up is at 12:00 PM. Afternoon activities begin at 1:30 PM. It is highly encouraged to have your camper here by 9:00 am for the morning or 1:30 for the afternoon, so that they have a chance to go over the daily rules and schedule with their group
- Due to DCF regulations, Sun Country is required to contact families that have not arrived within one hour of the start of camp (10:00 AM - morning or 2:30 PM - afternoon). If your child is sick or you know they will be absent, please let us know. Otherwise, you will receive a call from us to make sure everything is ok.
- We provide a wide variety of fun resources. Please do not allow your camper to bring any toys or other items.
- **Upon arrival, JR campers will remove their shoes and place them with other personal items in their cubby in Party Room One (these cubbies are specifically for Jr campers).**

Dress for Camp

- **Please send your camper with one bag that includes an extra set of clothes (just in case) and any water items on water day. All items (including your bag) should be clearly labeled with the campers first and last name.**
- For our outdoor playground, and for rock wall, campers must wear closed toed shoes.
- All campers should be dressed in athletic attire daily, with no buttons, snaps, or zippers.
- Dress to mess! We like to incorporate many hands-on activities, some of which can get messy. Please send your camper in clothes that you do not mind getting dirty.

Snacks and Lunch

- **Campers will need a water bottle labeled with first and last name every day.**
- Sun Country will provide a morning and afternoon snack. If you prefer to send your own, please make it a nutritious one.
- Campers staying for the full day will need to bring a healthy lunch. Please make sure all reusable containers are labeled with first and last name, and that lunch boxes have an ice pack. **We are not able to heat up food.*

Water Day (this will be done in lieu of swimming)

- For the safety of our youngest campers, water day will happen in lieu of swimming every Friday morning, **weather permitting.*
- We will have several water activities available, but children are always able to opt out if desired.
- **Please send your camper to camp with their water clothes on, sunscreen and bug spray already applied, with a towel and set of dry clothes (fully labeled).**

Happy Nappy (Optional "nap time")

- Naptime is from 1:15 - 2:45 PM every day. If your child naps, please send them with a crib sheet and blanket, as well as any comfort items that they need.
- Be sure all nap items are properly labeled with first and last name, placed in their bag, and placed on the cubbies in Party Room One.

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CAMP SUNNY/ CAMP SUNNY JR REQUIREMENTS

For the safety of our campers, their families, and our employees, Sun Country Sports Center has implemented the following summer camp guidelines:

CHECK IN/DROP-OFF:

- Campers ages 6 and older must be checked-in by a parent/guardian at the check-in tent where they will then be escorted by a Sun Country staff member to camp. Please allow extra time for drop off as we work to get everyone through our screening process smoothly.
- Campers ages 5 and under in Camp Sunny Jr. can be accompanied by 1 adult to check in at the Camp Sunny Jr classroom.
- Every person entering the building will be required to wash hands at one of the hand washing stations before being allowed to enter. All adults are required to wear a mask inside the building.
- Campers and parents (if applicable) will be screened prior to entry, which will include a touchless temperature check. If any of these apply to your camper, they will not be permitted to enter the facility for 14 days:
 - A fever of 100.4 or higher, has had a respiratory infection, cough, shortness of breath OR
 - Had any contact in the previous 14 days with someone who has a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19; is under investigation for COVID-19 or is ill with a respiratory illness OR
 - Has traveled in the previous 14 days on a cruise or internationally to countries with widespread, sustained community transmission OR
 - Has traveled out of the state, or out of the county to an area with widespread, sustained community transmission.
- Parents/Guardians will not be permitted to enter the facility outside of drop-off/pick-up time. However, you will be able to view your camper using SpotTV. Using our secure digital video system, registered camp parents can stream live feed of our fun activities right to your computer or mobile device! SpotTV subscription will be available for no additional charge. More info including SpotTV registration instructions coming soon!

PICK-UP:

- Families of Camp Sunny participants will be given 2 personalized car tags on their first day. At pick-up, please drive up to the check-out area, present your tag, and your camper/s will be brought out to you.
- Camp Sunny Jr. participants will be picked up in the classroom by one adult. If Camp Sunny Jr is not in the classroom, the adult should pick up items from their child's cubby and then will be escorted to where their camper's group is located.

REQUIRED ATTIRE/ITEMS:

- Footwear- campers will take off their shoes after check-in and put them in their cubby. Clean **socks must be worn** upon entering the facility and remain on until instructed to be removed by a counselor.
- Each camper must have their own bag or backpack with the following items:
 - Water bottle labeled with their first and last name. Water fountains are unavailable at this time. We will refill bottles as needed.
 - Lunch (if staying for the full day) with all items labeled.
 - Pencil case or small container that includes art supplies for the week: colored pencils or crayons, markers, a glue stick, and safety scissors.
- All items must be taken home and sanitized at the end of each week.
- We are asking for a donation of one pump hand sanitizer bottle per camper.
- Campers may bring and wear face masks, but they are not required to do so.
- We will be implementing physical distancing between campers throughout the day. Please discuss this with your camper and remind them that, at this time, we will not be permitting hugs, high fives or fist bumps.
