SUN COUNTRY PROTOCOL – IN ADDITION TO COUNTY ORDERS AND CDC GUIDELINES

Employee Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff follow COVID-19 Policy including temperature checks and 72-hour wellness standard • Staff wash/sanitize hands prior to, at the conclusion of and between classes • Staff are thoroughly trained on procedures and prepared to enforce distancing protocols • Hugs, high-fives and other greetings involving physical contact are not permitted • Employee travel is monitored and isolation following travel adheres to CDC recommendations
Facilities Preparedness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities and all equipment have been fully and thoroughly cleaned and disinfected using Clorox Pro-Quaternary disinfectant cleaner • Facilities staff are on-site to clean and disinfect all surfaces throughout the day during open hours • Drinking fountains are covered and converted to touchless water bottle filling stations • Hand sanitizer stations, touchless handwashing stations and touchless paper towel dispensers installed • Signage and markers throughout facilities indicate appropriate physical distancing and traffic flow • Protective barriers are installed at all customer service desks • Air Fresh™ chlorine dioxide (ClO₂) anti-viral diffusers are installed in all HVAC systems
PPE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All adults wear protective masks and/or face shields throughout their time in the facilities • Students are encouraged to wear protective masks, and will be required to wear masks during transitions and non-active programming beginning August 24th, 2020 • Staff are trained that vinyl gloves are not a substitution for handwashing
Entering the Facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No more than 1 adult per child in the building for ages 5 and under • Curbside drop off / pick up is required for students age 6 and older • Everyone is required to sanitize/wash hands at an outside station before entering facilities • Each person is screened and checked using a touchless thermometer before entering the building • If someone has a temperature of 100.4 or higher, or shows any illness symptoms, or has been in contact with someone else who shows any illness symptoms, they are not allowed to enter • Students must arrive dressed for class/practice and limit unnecessary items brought into the facilities • Online streaming video service is available for parents to observe class/practice
Physical Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scheduled activity start times are staggered, and everyone uses separate entrance and exit to control physical distancing and traffic flow • Student ratios are reduced and activity stations in programs are modified to allow physical distancing • Rock Wall open climb limited and scheduled by appointment only • Seating in viewing areas is spaced to provide 6ft between seats
During Class / Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students sanitize hands & feet (supervised) before entering each program activity area • Students sanitize hands after every rotation • Lesson plans are modified to omit partner activities • Props, mats and other equipment are disinfected after use of each activity group • Stations and activities are modified to provide additional distance between students where possible • Participants keep their own chalk and personal equipment separate and do not share
After Class / Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and parents use separate exit to control flow • Employees begin cleaning and disinfecting all areas of their room immediately to get ready for the next group • Commercial disinfectant foggers are used nightly throughout the entire facilities
